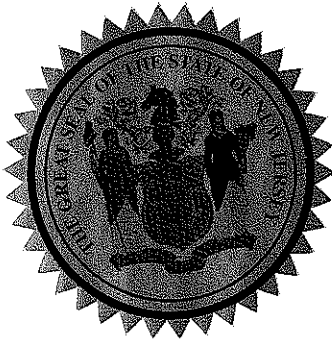

Congratulations! I am pleased to inform you that your company has been certified as a Minority Business Enterprise and/or Women Business Enterprise with the State of New Jersey. Your certificate is enclosed.

In order to use your certification effectively in pursuing business opportunities, you should consider these follow-up actions:

- The New Jersey Department of the Treasury maintains a Bidders' List of firms eligible to receive bid opportunities from some State agencies. If your firm is not on the Bidders' List, please call the Purchase Bureau at (609) 984-5396 to request an application.

Initial M/WBE certification is valid for one year. Recertification of this status is required after the first year, in accordance with **NJAC 12A: 11-1.3**. On or before your anniversary date, you must re-certify for a 5-year period, submitting a completed application, documentation as requested in question #8 only and a check or money order in the amount of \$75.00. Once your re-certification is approved, submission of the annual verification form is required. **Please note that no reminder notices will be sent to you.** It is the responsibility of the business owner to ensure that this document is completed and submitted each year.
